Randy Dunning Scores Key Endorsements from Rep. Jodie Laubenberg and RNC Committeewoman Denise McNamara

Campaign also announces 'blue-chip' list of conservative leaders supporting Dunning

(Garland) – The Randy Dunning for State Representative campaign today announced that Dunning has scored key endorsements from State Rep. Jodie Laubenberg, RNC Committeewoman Denise McNamara, and a blue-chip list of more than thirty-five respected grass roots and community leaders including Former Texas GOP Chairman Tom Pauken and Garland Mayor Ron Jones (see list at end of release).

Dunning is a candidate in the March 4th Republican Primary for House District 112, the seat being vacated by current State Representative Fred Hill. The district includes portions of both Garland and Richardson.

In endorsing Dunning, Rep. Laubenberg, a former Richardson resident who still enjoys strong ties in the district, said “Randy Dunning will be a champion for our conservative values in the legislature, and I am proud to endorse his candidacy. Taxpayers will have a strong advocate in Randy Dunning.”

Denise McNamara was elected as Texas Republican National Committeewoman in July of 2000 and has been a strong voice for maintaining the bedrock conservative principles of the Republican Party. McNamara said, “In a multi-candidate field, Randy Dunning has emerged as the choice for true conservatives. Republicans can count on Randy Dunning to be a rock-solid voice for the principles of limited government, strong families, and fiscal responsibility.”

Randy Dunning is the former Mayor Pro-Tem of Garland, a former GOP Precinct Chair and long-time Republican leader in his community. Randy was appointed to serve on State Senator Bob Deuell’s School Finance Advisory Committee, as well as the North Central Texas Council of Governments Emergency Preparedness Planning Council. He has worked in the cities of Garland and Richardson for over 20 years and is currently a Principal Software Engineer at Rockwell Collins Richardson. He received a Bachelor of Science Degree, Summa Cum Laude, at Oral Roberts University. Randy is married to his wife of 13 years, Karen, and together they have four daughters.
